Packages and Pricing

The pricing below is dependent on when your student joins the Peace of Mind program. The price shown in the 2025 total price is the full amount you will pay, the rate is guaranteed and will not increase over the 4 years. This package includes the GetTheEdge College Admissions Package. For example, if your student joins as a freshman in 2025, and plans to use the National Package you will pay a maximum of \$9950 until they graduate high school.

Payment Schedule

- Freshman families have 6 equal installments.
- Sophomore families have 5 equal installments.
- First installment is due with the signed contract. Remaining installments are due at 6 month intervals. All installments are due by Nov 1. of senior year of the student.

Notes:

- *In National & IVY League Package, California and Texas count as 2 schools each. If you apply to California and Texas, you will subtract 4 from the total count for remaining number of schools/colleges left in your package. If you apply only to California or Texas, subtract 2.
- Some colleges have 14+ essays, some have 7, and very few have 0 essays. Whether or not a college has 14+ or 7 or 0 (no) essays, it will be considered as 1 college only.
